


Darning 2

This technique can be used to darn rips and holes larger than buttonhole foot R.

Machine Settings:



Foot: Satin Foot F

Foot Pressure: 3

Stitch Width: 5.0 - 7.0

Stitch Length: 0.2 - 0.3

Thread Tension: 2.8 - 3.4

Needle Thread: All-Purpose Thread

Bobbin Thread: All-Purpose Thread

1. Place the fabric under the foot.
2. Set stitch width between 5.0 - 7.0 and stitch length between 0.2 - 0.3.
3. Start sewing.
4. Press the Auto-Lock button when the darning is complete.

Tips:

- * Use variegated thread for the needle thread to give your darning a decorative look.
- * For extra support, or to strengthen the darn, pin or baste a backing fabric to the wrong side of the fabric to be darned.
